It's been quite a whirlwind! From March 2019 to June 2021 our organisation ballooned quickly, then, suddenly shrank back. There have been new faces- now gone; new objectives and a new project come and go in a two year period. We learnt much and we're ready to go again when new funding arrives. But when will that be?

School backpacks are a necessity for a child with a parent in prison. For these children ranging from 11 to 15 years, home is not always a nice place. Some do not want to go home after school. For some of them a backpack is their home away from home. It is not just school items; their life is in a backpack. These children carry a lot, not just the physical.

Three of the **GoActive Family Support** goals are:

- To Increase School engagement
- To work closely with school Well-Being Officers
- To help the community understand the importance of this crime prevention community service
